The Licensing Department are in receipt of a Street Trading application from Mr Stephen Connelly (Bears Great Escapes Limited).

The applicant currently benefits from a number of '*mobile*' licences to trade in certain areas of Worcester City.

However, this application is to trade from a **static** pitch in the area of the Riverside & Fountains.

Many of you will be aware of the fact that recently 'Piccadilly Whip' applied for a static licence in the same vicinity. However, this application was refused, due to the fact that the applicants wished to provide a catering trailer on the site. The refusal was due to weight restrictions in that area.

Mr Connelly's application is to trade from a static pitch on a **tricycle**.

The application and proposed trading area is attached. Be aware that the applicant is registered with Environmental Health as a Food Business, and this department has sight of the necessary Public Liability Insurance.

Closing date for comments to this application will be **29th May 2015**.

Please be advised that existing traders in that area (both Browns@ the Quay and Piccadilly Whip) will be emailed details of the application for comment, but clearly personal information relating to Mr Connelly will be redacted.
