I'm writing to oppose and object the notice on Cosgrove Close for a catering van between the hours of 4pm and 11pm.

Unfortunately we are really struggling with multiple antisocial behaviour incidents around our area and with myself and my young family (2 children, 3 years and 9 months), my mother and my father all living in very local roads and struggle with lots of anti social behaviour coming from the likes of McDonald's and the amount of cars speeding around the small roads after visiting these places late at night, I'm concerned about the increase of this again around even more roads and adding to already growing problem

I can almost guarantee that having this new catering van on the corner of the road will bring in more noise and more cars and just more nuisance for myself and my family along with 100s of other family's.

Another good point to mention is the rise in local road collisions, the distraction from the main road with a catering van there I would see this as a very important matter to try and stop.

We currently already have a local catering van, Luckys Lunchbox, they have been there for many, many years and have built up such a brilliant reputation and I feel as a local business owner myself, if this notice was allowed to go ahead for the new catering van, I feel it could be linked with Luckys Lunchbox and could be potentially damaging to their reputation they have built up for so so many years being in such close proximity to their location which again they have had for many years. Their license they hold is already between the hours of 7am and 11pm but close earlier to respect the local neighbourhood and to reduce antisocial behaviour keep between reasonable suitable hours.

I really hope you do consider my own, my family and my parents concerns which doesn't just affect us but multiple lives, including all local residents nearby and the livelihood of a local business man, his family and his staff, just 50 yards away from the plot wanting to be used on this application.

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Sir/Madam,

I write to make a representation regarding this application in my ward: 22/02006/STRETR. I have been contacted by residents who are uncomfortable with this application. These are the concerns raised by residents.

1. There have been instances of youth antisocial behaviour linked to late night traffic at other takeaway places within walking distance (McDonalds). This proposal is likely to increase residents' worries.
2. Road traffic is already an issue in this area in mid afternoon to early evenings. This proposal is likely to exacerbate this, if cars are turning and parking at the junction to stop for food.
1. 3. Residents are concerned that excess noise and litter pollution will come from the addition of this takeaway burger van. There is no bin provision on this junction at present. Locals are concerned litter nuisance will attract pests.

3. 4. The location, at this junction, opposite a residential area but on a busy road, could increase the risk of accidents.
- 4.
5. 5. There is already a takeaway burger van business, on the same road on this trading estate, about 100 yards from this proposed site. Lucky's Lunchbox is an established business open from the morning until about 3pm every day. This new proposal would stay open until 11pm in the same catchment.

7. 6. There is no car parking facility for customers of a takeaway burger van on this junction. The other van 100 yards away, has this, as it is off the main road.
